OPPOSITION TO THE NOVEMBER 2024 CITY OF LAS CRUCES BALLOT MEASURE: INCREASE IN GROSS RECEIPTS TAX RATE

WHEREAS, The Greater Las Cruces Chamber of Commerce is a regional organization tasked with strengthening the economic vitality of Las Cruces & the Mesilla Valley region by providing educational tools for new & existing businesses; and,

WHEREAS, The Las Cruces City Council passed an act on July 15, 2024 to place a ballot measure on the November 2024 election to increase City gross receipts tax by .3250%.

WHEREAS, The ballot measure approved will read as follows:

"Shall the City of Las Cruces impose a municipal gross receipts tax in the amount of three hundred twenty-five thousands of one percent (0.3250%), the revenues of which shall be used for funding capital improvements and maintenance for public safety, streets, parks, and other public facilities and critical infrastructure?"

- WHEREAS, The Chamber is 100% supportive of public safety initiatives i.e. Real Time Crime Center & Training Facility, along with other critical infrastructure needs in our City.
- WHEREAS, After thoughtful consideration & input from our membership, it is the opinion of the Board of Directors the following items:
 - a) This measure was fast tracked & didn't give ample time for in-depth research;
 - b) The wording on the ballot measure is very general in scope & no written guarantee of its use;
 - c) No proposed budgets presented for explanation of usage, and
 - d) No clear, concise communication presented to public

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, On July 23, 2024, by a majority vote, the Board of Directors for the Greater Las Cruces Chamber of Commerce voted to oppose passage of this measure in its current, approved form & wording.
